- Early pledge submission means quick check in!
- Check in begins 7:30am arrive early if you have not submitted your pledges and checks. Check in is at the Main Hanger of the Wings of Eagles Discovery Center ([www.WingsOfEagles.com](http://www.WingsOfEagles.com)). You may **tour the museum** and exhibits before and during the day of the ride. Tour begins for the Century Ride (100 miles) and Metric Century (60 miles) at 8:30am. There will be a group photo at the front of the Museum. The photo will be posted on the web and available to download.
- The ten (10) mile ride begins at 12:00pm.
- Stops will be located at various points, TBA. Water and snacks will be provided.
- There will be vehicles stationed along the route with some repair equipment to assist with break downs.
- There will be a central phone number available ride day to contact for emergencies or pick up for disabled bikes.

### Ten (10) mile Ride:

- Fun Ride will begin at 12:00pm.
- There is a ten mile loop from the museum. Qualifying riders will receive the same perks as Long Distance riders.
- A **Qualifying Rider** is a rider that obtains pledges totaling \$50.00 or more. A Qualifying Rider is entitled to a T-shirt, water bottle, and food at the end of the ride.

- A **Participating Rider** is a rider that does not obtain \$50.00 in pledges. Participating Riders will not receive a T-shirt, water bottle, or food at the end of the ride.
